



A New Place for Resources, Reference, and Respite

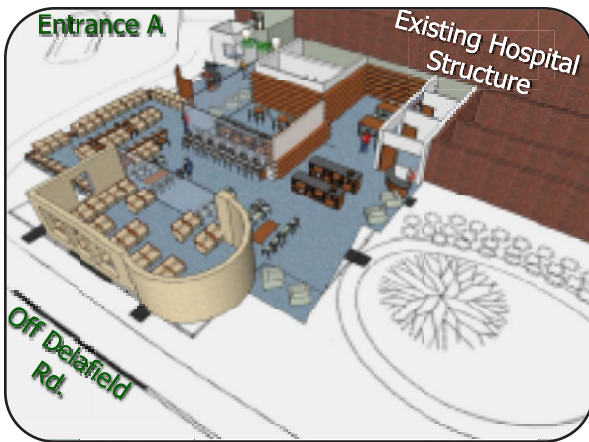

The clinical, sterile nature of the building doesn't lend itself to a comfortable place to relax especially in stressful and worrisome times. Your mind wanders with worry while the time passes by more slowly than ever, and you wonder to yourself...how long have I been here?

St. Margaret Foundation is joining hands with UPMC St. Margaret to create a place of respite, comfort and education for patients, and visitors of the hospital. The Patient/Family Resource Pavilion will be a sanctuary for those who need to step away from anxiety of a hospital visit, a place to relax and re-group, or education regarding an illness, medication or procedure.

"I think it's valuable to have an easily accessible and comfortable place for patients and their families to augment their

knowledge of their medical conditions," said Kevin O. Garrett, MD, FACS, Chief of Surgery at UPMC St. Margaret and board member of St. Margaret Foundation.

This will be a haven where families may check email, send a fax, charge their cell phone, access computers, or find a room to meet privately with a physician.

From the President

Dear Friends,

The Giving Foundation USA recently released their Giving USA 2009 report which showed that charitable giving by Americans fell 3.6 percent to \$303.8 billion last year while there was an increase in giving to health services by 3.8 percent to \$22.5 billion. Researchers at In-

diana University's Center on Philanthropy, who compile the Giving USA report, found this rise second only to an increase in giving to international agencies by 6.2 percent for an estimated \$9 billion.

As with the Great Depression of the 1930s, donations increase to health and human services during difficult economic times as people try to reach out to those with the most imminent need. The 2009 targeted increase in giving to these sectors comes in spite of the largest drop in overall giving since Giving USA began tracking contributions in 1956.

For 2009, 75 percent of contributions came from individuals, 13 percent from foundations, 8 percent from charitable bequests, and 4 percent from corporations.

Giving to St. Margaret Foundation for the health and wellness of the people in this community has increased, as well, thanks to generosity of our kind donors. Here are some of the highlights: 1) With a refocusing of priorities across the last eight months of the fiscal year ending June 30, we raised more money than the same period last year with three less employees. The total raised during this eight-month time period for fiscal year 2010 was \$367,322 and last year it was \$324,705; 2) Corporate sponsorship donations during this time were up more than 250% to \$55,000 from 15 corporate sponsors to 64; and, 3) Hospital employees donated more than \$62,000 during our recent Employee Campaign as compared to roughly \$30,000 last year.

Our mission at St. Margaret Foundation remains focused on the health and wellness of this community and our case for support is even stronger as the people we serve need our help now more than ever. When people lose their jobs, they lose their health benefits. But they still get sick.

In this newsletter and annual donor report, you will find stories about our patient heroes who have endured hardship and challenge with grace and poise.

Free Shuttle Provides Local Seniors With a Way to Stay Active in the Community

St. Margaret Foundation renewed its partnership with North Hills Community Outreach: Free Rides for Seniors with a grant for Fiscal Year 2011 so that our community's senior citizens who no longer are able to drive or have a vehicle may access grocery stores, pharmacies, doctor's offices, UPMC St. Margaret, other merchants and personal residences.

A 14-passenger transportation van operates out of the North Hill Community Outreach location in Lighthouse Pointe on the shore of the Allegheny River. With a simple phone call, riders in Sharpsburg, Aspinwall, and Blawnox who live south of Route 28 are picked up and taken to locations in that general vicinity. The shuttle is driven by volunteers Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. In fiscal year 2010, more than 6,373 rides were provided for 207 seniors, age 60 and over.

In the words of a senior citizen rider: "Since I no longer am able to drive, I still feel like a member of the community because I

can get my own groceries, go to my doctors' appointments, and just get out of this apartment when I want to get fresh air. I feel safe and really enjoy the company of the volunteers and other riders."

Were it not for your support, some of these stories would not have had the same ending. You made the difference.

This year, your generosity and your compassion extended beyond the normal call to meet the growing needs of an aging population in a stressed economy. In a hospital that does not deliver babies, rest assured that 100 percent of the people seeking care here would rather not be in a hospital at all. But who plans to be sick? Who expects to have a loved one fall ill? Who anticipates that they will need treatment at a hospital four days a week when they might not have transportation?

On our campus right now there is a large need that requires our sincere attention. In 1980 when this facility was built, lifestyles were different. People didn't use cell phones, fax machines, e-mail, or have access to electronic information that could help them with medical challenges. So imagine leaving your home or office in an emergent situation and heading to the hospital for either yourself or a loved one. You forget to grab your phone

charger and certainly don't think about a laptop. Then you or your loved one are admitted to the hospital where the average stay is four to five days. If you are the loved one you may be eating two meals a day in the cafeteria and confined to your loved ones' patient room for the remainder of the time.

A Patient/Family Resource Pavilion is needed to help ease the angst of our patients and families and return them to their daily routines while they are confined to our campus. Such a Pavilion provides a calm escape away from the bedside for patients and family members to relax and regroup – a respite from the overwhelmingly clinical nature of a hospital. This will be a place where families may check e-mail, send a fax, charge their cell phone, access computers, find a room to meet privately with a physician. The Pavilion will give away free books, newspapers, magazines, booklets, and other information on various diseases and treatment options in a healing surrounding with plants and music therapy.

It will have a medical librarian to help patients and families responsibly research a difficult diagnosis, various home care programs, or other medical services as well as to just serve as a source of comfort in this process. The librarian will and already does serve as a medical resource for other libraries in the community. It will be open to the public with access 24 hours a day. Philanthropy will be the only way that this Pavilion will come to be at St. Margaret.

We look forward to sharing our need for the Patient Family/Resource Pavilion with the community. Please contact us if we may present to your club or organization on the ways that St. Margaret Foundation fills in the gaps with hope and allow us to share with your group details about our new Pavilion.

Donor in the Spotlight: Sally H. Horsman

It was September 25, 1960 – the day the Pittsburgh Pirates beat the Milwaukee Braves and clenched their first pennant in 33 years, which

put them at the top of the National League. People paraded on the streets of Pittsburgh to celebrate the victory. Sally Houck was on her first date with Thomas Horsman, and they were thrilled.

At that time, Sally lived in a carriage house on the lane in Squirrel Hill, after graduating from Allegheny in 1959 with a BA in History. She didn't know that September 25 would not only mark the day the Bucs won the Pennant, but also the beginning of her future with Tom. They were married two years later in 1962.

They had two children – Cynthia, who now lives in Annapolis, MD, and Richard, who lives in Ann Arbor, MI. Sally loves to garden and used to ride horses. She still enjoys helping handicapped riders two times a week at Riding for the Handicapped of Western Pennsylvania. Sally and Tom enjoy spending time at their favorite restaurant, The Aspinwall Grille & Pub. They have spent a lot

of time traveling to different countries through the National Geographic Grosvenor Council, where Sally has been involved for 15 years. Their favorite vacation was to Baddeck, Nova Scotia, Canada.

Tom has been a frequent patient at UPMC St. Margaret over the past 2 years. In March of 2008, he was in severe condition with Pulmonary Fibrosis. The doctors and nurses at UPMC St. Margaret saved his life. That July, Sally decided that she wanted to give back to the hospital, by becoming a member of the St. Margaret Founda-

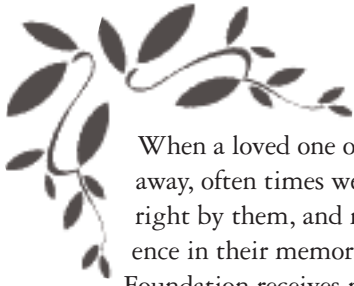
Poinsettias for Patients Coming Soon!

Real Stories — Real Purpose

Below are stories of how The Bed Fund and The Employee Emergency Fund fill in the gaps with hope.

A 60-year-old man stopped taking all of his medications after his unemployment benefits ran out and had not taken his medications for two months prior to being seen by his primary care physician. He had a history of cardiac problems and had a pacemaker. Through The Bed Fund, we were able to provide a month's supply of his medications while we wait for his application for indigent funding for medication from the pharmaceutical companies.

A 59-year-old man required intravenous antibiotics for his infected foot. He resided alone and had no transportation to the Medical Unit at the hospital for the daily treatments and was unable to walk to a bus stop. Cab slips were issued through The Bed Fund to transport him to the hospital for treatment. This has allowed the man to remain at home instead of being placed in a nursing home to receive his intravenous antibiotics.

In July, a husband with two small children has a history of a stroke and bleeding disorder. He lived 50 miles away from UPMC St. Margaret and was receiving blood transfusions at the hospital twice a week. He did not have the means to pay for gas. St. Margaret Foundation was able to fund his transportation through The Bed Fund so he could get to his crucial treatments.

In August, a 45 year-old-man with lymphoma was receiving radiation treatment as an outpatient. He had no source of income and was living without his pain and nausea medication for his cancer treatments due to the expense of the prescriptions. The Bed Fund provided him a month supply of both medications to ensure that his symptoms from the cancer and radiation are being relieved as well as assisting with transportation to the hospital for his radiation treatments. This man cried from gratitude and wanted to express his appreciation for the kindness of others to help him.

An employee lost her home in a fire while she was in St. Margaret's recovering from back surgery. Since she was on leave for so many months due to her medical issues, she had little means to rent a place to stay. St. Margaret Foundation provided funding for the security deposit on her apartment. She could then return to work with the peace of mind she needed to do her job.

An employee needed to get to Turkey to say his final goodbye to his mother, as she was nearing death. St. Margaret Foundation paid for a plane ticket so that he could see his mother one last time, and be with his family in a time of sorrow.

Current Spaces ...

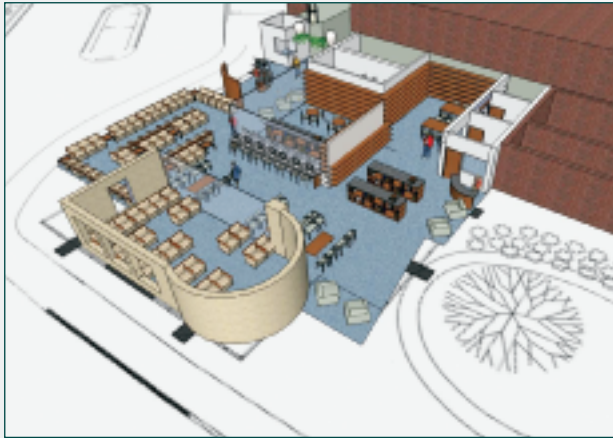


This is currently the largest area for waiting and respite aside from the cafeteria. The area is crowded and can be designed to be more comfortable for the long periods of time people spend there.
